The safety of our felines is our main concern, so an urban or low-profile property would best suit us. Funds will also be needed for our move. 100% of monies donated go directly to the care, adoption and sheltering of our felines. **We are an all-volunteer organization** and 75% funded by generous individuals from our community.
